TRANSPORT IN PRAGUE

Please note that there are permanent changes to the PIT (PRAGUE TRANSPORT) System as of the 7th April 2015 (related to the newly opened metro section), so please pay attention to the following informations.

How to get from the Prague Airport ("Václav Havel Airport Prague") to the city-centre?

Bus Lines from the Prague Airport:

- TO THE CENTRE: BUS n° 119: Prague Airport Nádraží Veleslavín metro station (metro line A)
 17 min (Nádraží Veleslavín Můstek or Muzeum metro line A exit directly in St Wenceslas Square)
- TO THE CENTRE: **Airport express (AE)**: Prague Airport Prague Main Train Station (metro line C "Hlavní nádraží" and connection to SC, EC, IC and EN trains) 35 min, extra tarif
- BUS n° 100: Prague Airport Zličín (metro line B) 18 min

Which means of transport can I use in Prague?

For transport around Prague please see the link of **Prague Public Transport Company, a.s**. where you can find all the necessary informations, maps and journey planners: <u>http://www.dpp.cz/en/</u>

Generally, you can travel by **METRO** (lines A, B, C), **TRAMS** and **BUSES/METROBUSES** – all these transport networks are completely interconnected. There is also night public transport.

How much does the Prague transport cost?

Basic public transport ticket for 90 min. costs 32 CZK (ca. 1,2 EUR) for 1 adult (the same price also for students). You can buy it in tobacconists or in the metro stations (there are ticket vending machines) or directly in the bus (here you will only pay a slightly higher price of ticket)
Short-term ticket (for 30 min.) costs 24 CZK (ca. 0,9 EUR) for adult and student.
1-day ticket costs 110 CZK (ca. 4 EUR) and 3-days ticket costs 310 CZK (ca. 11 EUR)



All hotels in Prague 1 are within walking distance from the venue. With a more distant accommodation, one has to pay attention to available Tram (9, 17, 18, 22) and Metro (ideally A) lines.
