The aim of this conference is to build new bridges between young archaeologists and to encourage them to present their work, exchange ideas and meet colleagues working in the related fields.

All presented papers, reviewed upon their submission by respective conference mentors, will be published electronically as Conference proceedings.

Travel, accommodation and all other costs (admissions to the museums, transfer by public transport, etc.) are to be covered by the participants themselves.
